5. Does the community perform fire or safety drills?

Future care questions:

1. What insurances are accepted?
2. What do you offer in your continuum of care for the future?
3. What happens when I need additional services?
4. What is the ratio of staff to residents during the day/night?
5. Do you offer medication management?
6. What is the pricing for additional care add-on? What additional care add-ons are offered?
